Prof. Zamir Halpern

Prof. Zamir Halpern was born in Israel in 1952 in Tel Aviv.

Upon graduation from high school began his medical studies in Jerusalem and received his MD at the Hebrew University. In 1981 began his residency in internal medicine At Ichilov Hospital with Prof. Yoram Levo And gastroenterology with Prof. Tuvia Gilat. He studied diseases of the Royal Free Hospital liver, London, England, following this, he conducted the service of liver diseases in this dept. In 1992 he managed the gastroenterology dept. at the Edith Wolfson Medical Center and Gastroenterology dept. at the Tel-Aviv Medical Center from 1996-2017.

In parallel of his clinical practice Prof. Halpern Focus on research, He acquired his Research training in Cleveland Clinic in the pathogenesis of gallstones and then immune and inflammatory diseases of the digestive system. He established a research laboratory affiliated with the University of Tel Aviv with a variety of research groups involved in the study of Microbiom, Mucosal vaccination, obesity, nutrition and liver diseases.

He has published over 200 original works. Prof. Halpern was Chairman of the Israeli Association of the Study of Liver , Chairman of the Israeli Association of gastro, chairman of the National Council for Food and Agriculture and is now chairman of the National gastro nutrition and liver diseases Council , the Ministry of Health and Charge of the Cathedra name of engineer Gremanis and Dr. Kaufmann.
